STATEMENT ON THE MIGRATION CRISIS AND MULTICULTURALISM

The Community of Hungarian Patriots, as a civic organization, feels it is its responsibility to comment upon the most relevant contemporary cultural and social issues. Because of our shared responsibility, we must take a stand in relation to the mass migration affecting Europe and the Carpathian Basin.

The Hungarian people, ever since the Mongolian invasions of the Middle Ages, have consistently defended Christian Europe. We lost about one third of ethnically Hungarian territories during the Mongolian and Ottoman invasions and occupations, and, as a consequence of these wars, the Hungarian Kingdom became a multiethnic country. In spite of minority policies that were, even by contemporary standards, quite tolerant, various forces led to the Treaty of Trianon and the consequent dismemberment of Hungary. Hungarians cannot become once again the pawns of international diplomacy and geopolitics. Various geopolitical forces are seeking to import masses of people into Europe, and this must be stopped.

The waves of mass migration arriving from Serbia is a test for our national unity, and a threat to our Christian culture. We agree with the Hungarian Government's stance in relation to this matter, and oppose the essentially economically driven immigration. We agree that Hungary's territory must be defended in such a situation. Hungarian society has a range of unresolved local issues, some of which originated in the one-sided embrace of Western ideological constructs on the part of the new democratic Hungarian elites.

It is our belief that the order of Creation demands that we maintain diversity among the peoples of the world. Each people can only fulfil its role if allowed to live in its own locality. There is a lifeworld on Earth for each nation, indeed, for each form of life. When taken out of their lifeworlds, or when intruders displace them, lifeforms cannot survive. We are bound to place. The national character of a nation is a complex web that should not be radically modified. Global problems can only be resolved if we return to our own lifeworlds, if we find our way back to our respective worlds. False idols such as „tolerance”, „multiculturalism”, „universalism” and „globalism” must be left behind, if we are to arrive at true solutions to the ever more pressing issues facing our planet. The current globalist de-civilization is a dead end. We do not want the Hungarian people to remain stuck in this maze.

Our lives and our culture are both in jeopardy. Hungary may, indeed, must give sanctuary to persecuted Christians, in so far as they are compatible with local ways of life.
